# STATUS REPORT FOR THE 4<sup>TH</sup> QUARTER OF 2021

(OCTOBER - DECEMBER 2021)

ENSURING COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT ACT, 2003, (ACT 663), AND AMENDED ACT 914 AND ITS OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES, WITHIN THE ESTABLISHED THRESHOLDS.

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## 1.0 OVERVIEW

Established under Section 20 of the Public Procurement Act, 2003 (Act 663), the Central Tender Review Board (CTRB), now the Central Tender Review Committee (CTRC) is mandated to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement Act by Procurement Entities.

## 1.1 Performance for the Fourth Quarter 2021

Within the period (October – December 2021), the CTRC considered evaluation reports submitted by the Procurement Entities as detailed in the tables and charts below.

The table above is a representation of all the submissions received from the various entities during the period under review classified into the various types of Procurements (Goods, Service and Works). During the fourth (4th) quarter 2021, the Committee reviewed a total of One Hundred and Fifty (150) evaluation reports. Of this total, procurement of Goods (Supplies) totalling eighty-nine (89) represented 59% of the total procurements made within the period. Procurement of Works totalling Forty-two (42) representing 28% and procurement of Services totalling Nineteen (19) representing 13% of the total submissions made within the period under review.

The month of December is recorded to have the most submissions (71) reviewed. Of this number, twelve (12) were reviewed under Emergency Sitting and Fifty-nine (59) were reviewed during the regular sitting. October recorded the second highest (42) number of reviewed submissions, with Twelve (12) been reviewed at Emergency Sitting and Thirty (30) during the regular sitting. Lastly, in the month of November, Thirty-Seven (37) submissions were reviewed; three (3) at Emergency Sitting and Thirty-Four (34) during the regular sitting.

At the end of the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Quarter, the procurement of Goods remained the same as that of the previous Quarter (3<sup>rd</sup>), the procurement of Services fell short of that of the previous Quarter (3<sup>rd</sup>) by approximately 3% and that of Works exceeded that of the previous Quarter (3<sup>rd</sup>) by approximately 3%.

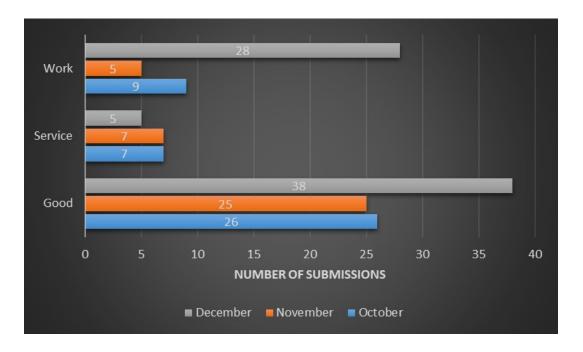


Figure 1.1.1 Submission by Type of Procurement

From Figure 1.1.1, the procurement of Goods outnumbered the other types of procurement. It is notable that the procurement of automobiles (cars, buses, vehicles) summed up to 36 of the total reviewed submissions under Goods making approximately 40% of the total submissions reviewed under Goods.

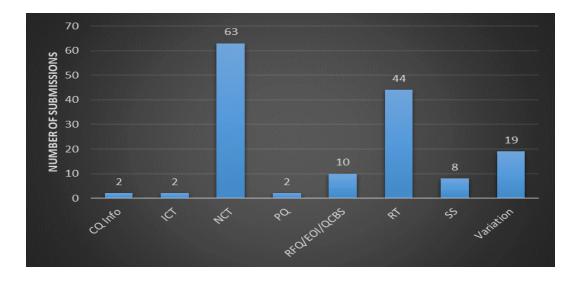


Figure 1.1.2 Submissions by Method of Procurement.

Figure 1.1.2 summarizes the procurement submissions in the fourth quarter of 2021 by the methods. From the figure above, the method with the highest frequency during the fourth quarter is the NCT (42%), followed by the RT (29%), variation/addendum (13%), RFP/QOI/QCBS and SS taking up 7% and 5% respectively. While the least used methods are CQ (1%), ICT (1%) and PQ (1%).

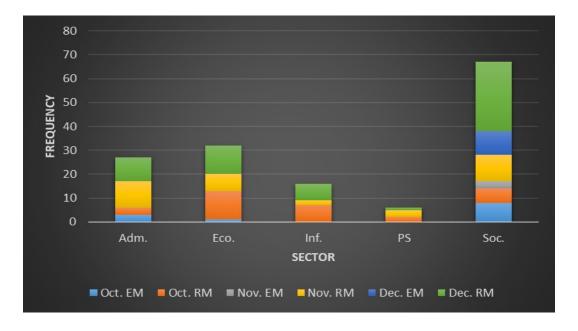


Figure 1.1.3 Graphical Representation of Submission by Sector of Procurement

Figure 1.1.3 summarizes the procurement submissions in the fourth quarter of 2021 by sectors. Sixty-Eight (68) entities submitted various procurements for approval. Eleven (11) from the Administrative Sector, seventeen (17) from the Economic Sector, Eleven (11) from the Infrastructure Sector, Twenty-Six (26) from the Social Sector and Three (3) from the Public Safety Sector. From the figure above, the Sector with the highest procurements is the Social Sector.

Within the Social Sector, the Ministry of Health recorded the highest submission totalling Fifteen (15), which is equivalent to 18% of the total submissions within the Social Sector. Of the total submissions made by the Ministry of Health, ten (10) were looked at under Emergency Meeting while Two (2) were reviewed during regular Meeting. All Ten submissions reviewed at the Emergency Sittings centred to manage the COVID-19 pandemic in the country. The second highest procurements are from the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST) with a total of ten (10) procurements. All of the referenced submissions for KNUST were reviewed during regular meetings.

The second highest of procurements by Sectors is the Economic with Thirty-Two (32) submissions. The entity with the highest submissions in the Economic Sector is the Ministry of Energy (MoEn) with seven (7) submissions reviewed during regular Meetings. Five (5) of the submissions reviewed were on the Supply of Electrical Materials while the remaining Two (2) were on Supply of Vehicle and Single Burner LPG Cook Stoves.

The Administrative Sector recorded the third (3rd) highest number of submissions. Within the Sector, the National Identification Authority (NIA) recorded the highest number of procurement submissions totalling Eight (8); Three (3) were reviewed under Emergency Sitting and Five (5) were reviewed at regular Sittings.

The Sector to record the fourth (4th) highest number of submissions is the Infrastructure Sector. Within the Sector, Ghana Highway Authority (GHA) recorded the highest number with Five (5) submissions. Of the five

submissions reviewed during the regular meetings, four (4) were variations to previously approved projects while one was a first time submission.

The Sector to record the least number of procurement submissions within the fourth (4th) quarter is the Public Safety Sector. The Ghana Immigration Service (GIS) is the entity to have recorded the highest number (3) of procurement submissions within the fourth (4th) quarter of 2021 within the Public Safety sector.

At the end of the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) quarter, 19% of the reviewed submissions were from the Administrative Sector, 21% were from the Economic Sector, 11% from the Infrastructure Sector, 4% from the Public Safety Sector and 45% from the Social Sector.

Of the One Hundred and Fifty (150) evaluation reports received during the period, Forty-Nine (49) submissions under Goods were approved, Thirty-Eight (38) received under Goods had issues to address and/or clarify hence not granted concurrent approval and Two (2) were asked to negotiate on the contract price to achieve a satisfactory price offer. Of the Forty-nine (49) that were approved, Thirty-Seven (37) were granted approval during regular meetings whereas Twelve (12) were granted approval during Emergency Meetings. Of the Thirty-Eight (38) not granted approval, thirty (30) were during the Committee's regular meeting and eight (8) were during Emergency Meetings.

Nineteen (19) procurement submissions received under Services, ten (10) were granted concurrent approval while nine (9) has issues to address and/or clarify hence not granted concurrent approval.

Again, the approved procurement submissions under Works totalled twenty (20). Nineteen (19) were approved during regular Meetings and One (1) approved under Emergency Meeting. Twenty-One (21) were not granted concurrent approval. Seventeen (17) were reviewed during regular meetings and Four (4) under Emergency Meetings.

However, in reviewing the Works submission by Public Utilities Regulatory Commission, the Committee advised the Entity to proceed without reference to the CTRC as the percentage in price adjustment is less than 10% of the original contract amount.

In conclusion, Seventy-Nine (79) of the submissions reviewed, representing 53% received outright approvals. On the contrary, Sixty-Eight (68) of the reviewed submissions, representing 45% had issues that needed to be addressed and/or clarified and re-submission by the procurement entities. Upon review, entities submissions (2) representing 1% were advised to negotiate on the contract price to achieve a satisfactory price offer, whiles another 1% was however advised to proceed without reference to the CTRC.

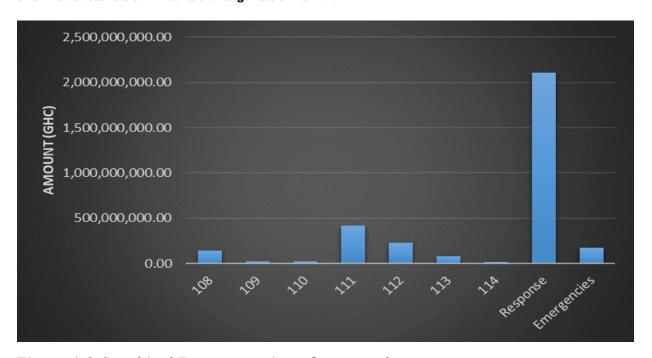


Figure 1.3 Graphical Representation of approved amount.

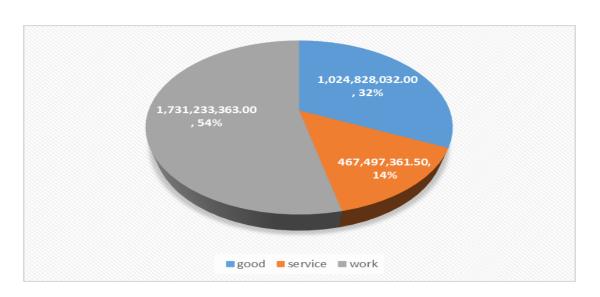

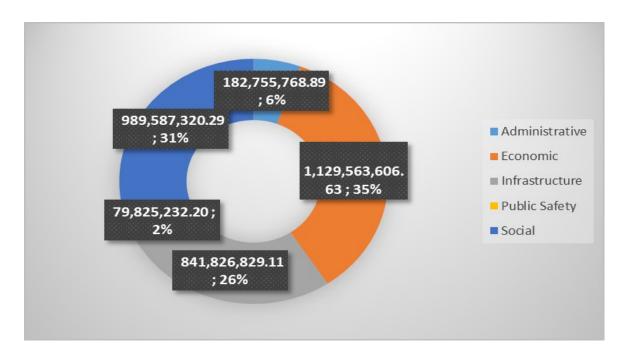


Figure 1.3.2Graphical Representation of approved amount by sector of procurement.

From figure 1.3, the highest approved amount is Two Billion, One Hundred and Ten Million, Four Hundred and Forty-Three Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty-Nine Ghana Cedi (GH¢2,110,443,449.00) generated from Responses (Submissions that were not given approval on their first review). The least amount, Seventeen Million, Six Hundred and Twenty-Seven Thousand, Nine

Hundred and Eleven Ghana Cedi and Eleven Pesewas (GH¢17,627,911.11) was approved during the 114<sup>th</sup> regular Sitting. The Two Hundred and Thirty-Six (236) procurement submissions that were given approval during the regular and emergency Sittings as well as responses from previous quarters amounted to Three Billion, Two Hundred and Twenty-Three Million, Five Hundred and Fifty-Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred and Fifty-Seven Ghana Cedi (GH¢3,223,558,757.00) for the period under review. This amount resulted from the satisfactory review of Sixty-Six (66) new procurement submissions during the regular sittings, thirteen (13) new procurement submissions during the emergency Sittings and Eighty-Three (83) responses to submissions that weren't given approval on their first review.

From figure 1.3.1, at the end of the fourth quarter, procurement made under Goods amounted to One Billion, Twenty-Four Million, Eight Hundred and Twenty-Eight Thousand, and Thirty-Two Ghana Cedi (GH¢1,024,828,032.00) representing 32% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ministry of Health was given approval to the tune of Four Hundred and Sixty-Nine Million, Seventy Thousand, Two Hundred and Forty-Four Ghana Cedi and Four Pesewas (GH¢469,070,244.4), which represents 46% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for Goods from the satisfactory review of Thirteen (13) procurement submissions under Goods.

Procurement made under Services amounted to Four Hundred and Sixty-Seven Million, Four Hundred and Ninety-Seven Thousand, Three Hundred and Sixty-One Ghana Cedi and Fifty Pesewas (GH $^4$ 467,497,361.50) representing 14% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ghana National Petroleum Corporation was given approval to the tune of Four Hundred and Thirty-Five Million, Four Thousand, Eight Hundred and Sixty-One Ghana Cedi and One Pesewa (GH $^4$ 435,004,861.01  $\cong$  US\$73,581,227.88), which represents 93% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for Services from the satisfactory review of one (1) procurement submission (Decommissioning of Saltpond Field) under Services.

Procurement made under Works amounted to One Billion, Seven Hundred and Thirty-One Million, Two Hundred and Thirty-Three Thousand, Three Hundred and Sixty-Three Ghana Cedi (GH¢1,731,233,363.00), which represents 54% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ghana Highway Authority was given approval to the tune of Seven Hundred and Twenty-Six Million, Two Hundred and Sixteen Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifteen Ghana Cedi and Eight Pesewas (GH¢726,216,215.8), which represents 42% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for Works from the satisfactory review of four (4) procurement submissions under Works.

From the figure above, procurement made by the Administrative Sector amounted to One Hundred and Eighty-Two Million, Seven Hundred and Fifty-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and Sixty-Eight Ghana Cedi and Ninety

Pesewas (GH¢182,755,768.90), which represents 6% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Office of the Head of Local Government Services was given approval to the tune of Eighty Million, Twenty-One Thousand, Two Hundred and Sixty-Eight Ghana Cedi and Forty-One Pesewas (GH¢80,021,268.41), which represents 44% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for the Administrative Sector from the satisfactory review of four (4) procurement submissions.

Procurement made by the Economic Sector amounted to One Billion, One Hundred and Twenty-Nine Million, Five Hundred and Sixty-Three Thousand, Six Hundred and Seven Ghana Cedi (GH¢1,129,563,607.00). This represents 35% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ghana National Petroleum Corporation was given approval to the tune of Eight Hundred and Twenty-Nine Million, Seven Hundred and Seventy-Four Thousand, Nine Ghana Cedi and Four Pesewas (GH¢829,774,009.04). This represents 73% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for the Economic sector from the satisfactory review of four (4) procurement submissions.

Procurement made by the Infrastructure Sector amounted to Eight Hundred and Forty-One Million, Eight Hundred and Twenty-Six Thousand, Eight Hundred and Twenty-Nine Ghana Cedi and Ten Pesewas (GH¢841,826,829.10) representing 26% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ghana Highway Authority was given approval to the tune of Seven Hundred and Twenty-Six Million, Two Hundred and Sixteen Thousand, Fifteen Two Hundred and Ghana Cedi and Eight Pesewas (GH¢726,216,215.08). This represents 86% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for the Infrastructure Sector from the satisfactory review of five (5) procurement submissions.

Procurement made by the Public Safety Sector amounted to Seventy-Nine Million, Eight Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand, Two Hundred and Thirty-Two Ghana Cedi and Twenty Pesewas (GH¢79,825,232.20), which represents

2% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ghana Immigration Service was given approval to the tune of Forty-Three Million, Three Hundred and Thirty Thousand, Three Hundred and Ninety-One Ghana Cedi and Two Pesewas (GH¢43,330,391.02), which represents 54% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for the Public Safety Sector from the satisfactory review of three (3) procurement submissions.

Procurement made by the Social Sector amounted to Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine Million, Five Hundred and Eighty-Seven Thousand, Three Hundred and Twenty Ghana Cedi and Thirty Pesewas (GH¢989,587,320.30). This represents 31% of all reviewed submissions in the period under review. Of this amount, Ministry of Health was given approval to the tune of Four Hundred and Sixty-Nine Million, Seventy Thousand, Two Hundred and Forty-Four Ghana Cedi and Four Pesewas (GH¢469,070,244.4) which represents 47% (highest amount approved) of the approved value for the Social Sector from the satisfactory review of thirteen (13) procurement submissions.

## 3.0 ISSUES AND OBSERVATIONS RAISED

The most frequent issues and observations raised by the CTRC for further clarification by the procurement entities included the following:

- No documentary evidence provided on advertisement of method of procurement.
- No documentary evidence provided to justify the basis for the disqualification of tenderers and the invitation of tenderers.
- No procurement plan posted on the Public Procurement Authority's website.
- No price reasonableness analysis was carried out to assure value for money.
- No information provided to demonstrate availability of funding for the Procurement.
- Opening of financial proposals without seeking approval for technical evaluation offending Section 74 (2) of Act 663, as amended.

To enhance the Committee's review, procurement entities were to consider the following:

- ➤ Provide all the necessary documentation required by the CTRC to minimize referrals, which invariably lead to unnecessary delays in the procurement progress.
- ➤ Adhere strictly to the provisions of the Procurement Acts to overcome approval challenges.
- > Adhere strictly to evaluation criteria pre-disclosed in tender documents.

It is therefore recommended that training sessions are organized for procurement units in all entities to ensure improvement in procurement activities and to have value for money.

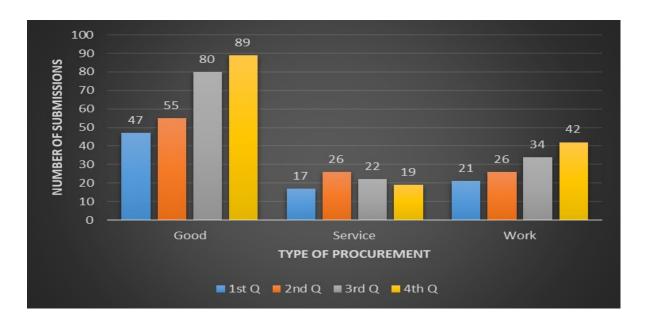


Figure 7.1 Number of Submissions by Type of Procurement

At the end of the 2021 Financial Year, the committee reviewed a total of four hundred and seventy-six (476) evaluation reports. Of this total, procurement of goods totalling two hundred and sixty-nine (269) made up 56% of the total procurements made within the year. Procurements under service totalling eighty-four (84) constituted 18% of all procurements made within the year. Procurements made under works totalling one hundred and twenty-three (123) constituted about 26% of all procurements made within the 2021 financial year.

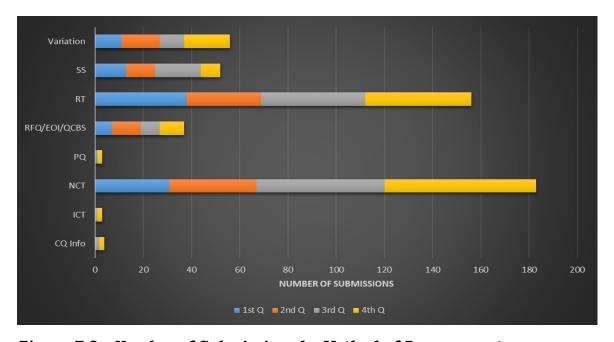


Figure 7.2 Number of Submissions by Method of Procurement.

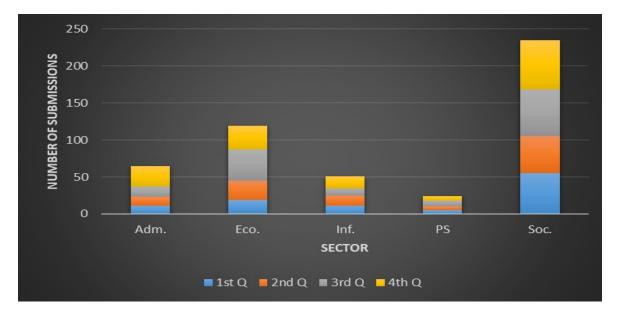


Figure 7.3 Number of submissions by Sector of Procurement.

Figure 7.3 summarizes the procurements made in the year of 2021 by the main Sectors. Sixty-five (65) submissions were reviewed from the Administrative Sector, one hundred and nineteen (119) from the Economic Sector, fifty-one (51) from the Infrastructure Sector, twenty-four (24) from the Public Safety Sector and two hundred and thirty-five (235) from the Social Sector. From the figure above, the Sector with the highest procurements submissions received

for review is the Social Sector (48%), followed by the Economic Sector (24%), the Administrative sector (13%), the Infrastructure Sector (10%) and lastly the Public Safety Sector (5%).

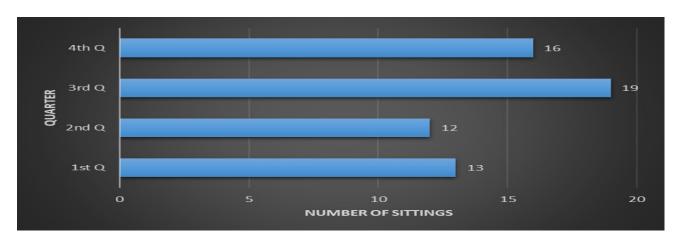


Figure 7.4 Number of Meetings held.

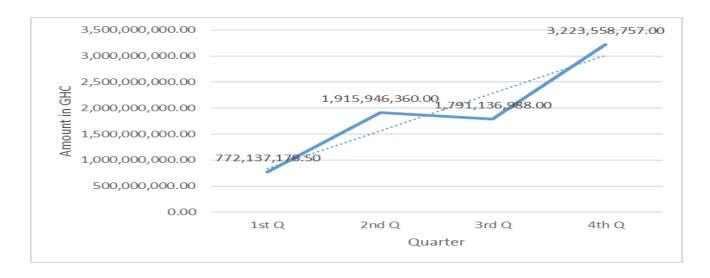

#### **APPENDIX**

#### A1 Profile

Since its Inauguration on 17th June 2005, the Central Tender Review Board (CTRB), now Central Tender Review Committee (CTRC), has continuously exercised the highest standards of transparency, disclosure, integrity, and best practice, in line with its function of ensuring compliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement Act, 2003 (Act 663) as amended, within its established authorized thresholds.

The role of the CTRC is clearly expressed in the Public Procurement Act, 2003 (Act 663), and Amendment Act 914 (Section 20F). The 9-member Committee has the following mandated functions:

- a. In relation to a particular procurement under consideration, review the activities at each step of the procurement cycle leading to the selection of the lowest evaluated Tender, best offer, by the Procurement Entity in order to ensure compliance with the Provisions of the Act and its operating instructions and guidelines;
- b. Subject to (a), give concurrent approval or otherwise to enable the Procurement Entity continue with the Procurement Process;
- c. Furnish the Procurement Board with reports in a prescribed format;
- d. Participate in Public Procurement Fora;
- e. Review decisions of Heads of Entities in respect of a compliant; and
- f. Engage the services of such Consultants and Advisors or co-opt persons with specialized expertise, as it may be required for the proper and efficient discharge of its functions.
