STATUS REPORT FOR THE 1^{ST} QUARTER OF 2021

(JANUARY - MARCH 2021)

ENSURING COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT ACT, 2003, (ACT 663), AND AMMENDED ACT 914 AND ITS OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES, WITHIN THE ESTABLISHED THRESHOLDS

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1.0 OVERVIEW

Established under Section 20 of the Public Procurement Act, 2003 (Act 663), the Central Tender Review Board (CTRB), now the Central Tender Review Committee (CTRC) is mandated to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement Act as amended (Act 914), by Procurement Entities.

1.1 Performance for the First Quarter 2021

Within the period under review (January - March 2021), the CTRC considered various reports submitted by Procurement Entities as detailed in Table 1,1 and Figure 1.1 below:

The report contains differentiation between submitted and reviewed evaluation reports. Submitted evaluation reports are those that are delivered by procurement entities to the CTRC Secretariat. The reviewed evaluation reports on the other hand are those reviewed by the CTRC. During the period under review, the Secretariat received one hundred and one (101) submitted evaluation reports. Of this total, procurement of goods (supplies) represented 62 percent, with works and services representing 21 and 17 percent, respectively. This high number of submissions for supplies (goods) is largely attributable to the emergency supplies and consumables in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. A similar observation was made in the previous year, 2020.

The distribution of the reports among the three types of procurement was similar to that of last year. In all the previous quarters for 2020, the percentage of submissions of supplies was higher than the other types of procurement, followed by works and services as shown in the Figure 1.1 below.

Figure 1.1: Submissions by Type of Procurement




Figure 1.1 summarizes the submitted evaluation reports by type of procurement activities received from the entities. The figure shows only the type of procurement submitted to the Committee for review.

In all, the Committee reviewed one hundred and one (101) submitted evaluation reports from procurement entities. Of this number, thirty-two (32) received outright approvals after the first review of the evaluation reports. Sixty-seven (67) evaluation reports had issues that needed re-examination or clarification and subsequent re-submission by the procurement entities. Some of the issues required corrections, which were necessary to offer clarity on the fairness of the evaluation process, and to demonstrate transparency in the entire procurement process. The remaining two (2) reports fell short of CTRC's threshold so were unconsidered for concurrent approval or otherwise.

Table 1.3 contains One hundred and one reviewed evaluation reports excluded fifty-two (52) carry-over responses from previous quarters of 2020. The total number of reports that received concurrent approval as well as the number of referrals subsequently approved following the satisfactory resolution of the Committee's issues were 153. In value terms the total approved reports was **GHS772.14 Million** for the review period. Emergency Meetings recorded the highest total value of reviewed evaluation reports (**GHS283.73 Million**) for the period under review.

Most frequent issues and observations raised by the CTRC for further clarification by the procurement entities included the following:

- No documentary evidence provided on advertisement of method of procurement;
- No documentary evidence provided to justify the basis for the disqualification of tenderers and the invitation of tenderers;
- No procurement plan posted on the Public Procurement Authority's website;
- No price reasonableness analysis carried out to assure value for money; and
- No information provided to demonstrate availability of funding for the procuremen.t

To enhance the Committee's review, Procurement Entities are to consider the following:

- ✓ Provide all the necessary documentation required by the CTRC to minimise referrals, which invariably lead to unnecessary delays in the procurement process.
- ✓ Adhere strictly to the provisions of the Procurement Acts to overcome approval challenges, and
- ✓ Adhere strictly to evaluation criteria pre-disclosed in tender documents.

- 1. No information provided on specifications of items and unit prices to confirm price reasonableness;
- 2. Expiration of tender validity period;
- 3. No documentary evidence provided on advertisement of method of procurement;
- 4. No documentary evidence provided to justify the basis for the disqualification of tenderers and the invitation of tenderers; and
- 5. Procurement activity not captured in procurement plan posted at the Public Procurement Authority's website.
- 6. No clarity provided on the basis for determining financial scores and recommended price offer in the financial evaluation and comparison of proposals.

RESPONSE TO BLOOMBERG'S ARTICLE ON GHANA'S DEBT

Accra, 16 January 2022 - On Thursday, 13th January 2022, the attention of the Ministry was drawn to a widely circulated Bloomberg article captioned – "Ghana Debt Moves Deeper into Distress as Investors lose Patience".

- 2. There are some serious factual errors in the article, which may give investors some cause for concern, if not corrected. For example, Bloomberg stated 81.5% as end of year debt to GDP ratio. This is incorrect. Our provisional nominal debt to GDP, as at the end of November 2021 was 78.4%, which is the latest data available. December revenue collections are seasonally the largest for any year, it is unlikely that our financing requirements in December will result in us exceeding 80% debt to GDP by December 2021.
- 3. The Bloomberg article gave wrong historical debt to GDP figures. It is essential we make the correction that Ghana's debt to GDP figures a decade ago was 39.67% and 47.80% for 2011 and 2012, respectively and not 31.4% as stated in the Bloomberg publication. Again, it is important to note that for the period prior to the COVID Pandemic, Ghana experienced an average debt-to-GDP ratio of 56.4% from 2015 to 2019. In 2020, Ghana's GDP contracted by 0.4% because of the impact of the Covid-19 Pandemic on the economy. Financing of the additional Covid-19 related expenditures, in addition to revised revenue targets, due to the impact of the pandemic, led to an increase in debt-to-GDP from 62.4% in 2019 to 76.1% in 2020.
- 4. The current 78.4% debt-to-GDP ratio as at the end of November 2021 indicates a reduction in the rate of debt accumulation (i.e. declined by a half to 18% as at November 2021 from 34% in 2020). This attests to an improvement in our debt and liability management, contrary to what the article says. Furthermore, with the positive Primary balance target for 2022 one of the key fiscal anchors in 2022 Ghana should see improved stability and reduction in the debt to GDP ratio in 2022 and through the medium term.
- 5. It is most unfortunate to note that foreign investors and market participants are on edge following the impasse in Parliament, in relation to the passage of the E-levy Bill. The market seems to now be pricing into our bonds, the perceived risks of having a slim majority in Parliament and the consequences thereof. The markets also seem to be concerned that this might impact Government's ability to successfully pass and implement some of its major revenue policy measures as presented in the 2022 Budget. The Ministry would like to state that a healthy debate in Parliament is a critical
